<p><b>The Jolly Postman</b></p> <p>The children will be learning about different types of letters, with reference to the text 'The Jolly Postman' by Janet and Allan Ahlberg. They will be identifying the features of different types of letters, looking at their purposes and developing their letter writing skills.
