Edinburgh Primary School is a school that has grown from a one form entry to a three form entry school. We benefit from a new building (2011). In September 2008 there were 203 children on roll now there are 580. Despite our growth Edinburgh remains a friendly and nurturing environment for staff, parents and children. Our children are motivated to learn and respond with enthusiasm to adults who are prepared to develop their teaching to excite them and enable them all to make progress whatever their starting point.

We are ambitious for our children and have a solid belief in developing the whole child working with families, the community and external agencies and offering a wide extended schools programme. Our curriculum is enriched by a wide variety of extracurricular activities, educational visits and visitors to the school. Our children enjoy school and are positive about the subjects they learn and about the range of activities and trips that take place.

The school is well resourced and we seek to use new technology alongside more traditional resources. We are developing our curriculum so that it continues to be engaging and suits the needs of our diverse community.

Our children and their parents are extremely positive about what the school provides and we are proud of how the school has developed but we are seeking to improve our school still further. We know that raising attainment and improving progress continues to be an area for further development and that all our children, but particularly our more able children, need continued challenge and high expectations. We are focusing on developing children as active and independent learners who take responsibility for their own learning. Our children need and deserve teachers who are prepared to be self-critical, reflective practitioners and who are able to adapt their teaching to suit the needs of the children so that all succeed.
